Sub: Approval of Syllabus for Middle Classes (I-VIII)

Dear Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated 03.05.2007 and subsequent correspondence with the school / inspection in this regard, I am directed to convey the grant for Provisional approval of the Competent Authority of the Board for Middle Classes syllabus for a period of three years w.e.f. 01.04.2008 to 31.03.2011.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:

1. "School will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT for the middle classes".
2. **The grant for approval of the middle classes does not in any way imply any obligation on the part of the Board to affiliate the Secondary Classes (IX-X).**
3. **The approval will also be subject to the condition that the school will make a fresh application for Provisional Affiliation of the Secondary Classes (IX-X) to the Board on the prescribed form in accordance with the rules and condition for Provisional Affiliation when class VIII has been started.**
4. The school shall appoint only qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
5. Service conditions, pay and allowances and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be in no way less than that of corresponding employees working in Government Schools of the State in which the school is located. An undertaking to this effect be sent to C.B.S.E.
6. The school should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers with computer student ratio of 1:20 and proper software alongwith facility of Broad Band Connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on' from any service provider.
7. The school shall promote inclusive education for with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the Persons with Disabilities Act -1995'.
8. **Service agreement be executed with the staff as per norms generally accepted by the State Government concerned.**

9. The school and its records shall be open for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorised representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
10. The rate of tuition fee and other fees charged should be commensurate with the facilities provided.
11. The admission to the school shall be open to all without any discrimination on the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
12. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
13. The school will abide itself by the rules and conditions for affiliation as given in the Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
14. The affiliation Code Number allotted to your school is 830239. This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with the Board.
15. Reserve Fund be maintained in the joint name of the Secretary, CBSE and the School Authorities in accordance with the enrolment in the school from time to time.
16. As per Annexure 'A'

Conditions for immediate compliance:

1. The school is required to appoint a qualified Librarian.
2. The proper furniture may be provided as per the classes and the age of the students.
3. The school is required to enrich the library with more books of CBSE/NCERT.
4. Separate corner may be provided for teachers in the library.
5. The school is required to demarcate the playground for different games.
6. The school is required to ensure that pay-scales, DA and other admissible allowances are being paid at par with the corresponding categories of employees working in the State Govt. Schools as per Affiliation Bye-laws of the Board and disburse the salary through Bank & also submit photocopy of acquittance roll after complying with the above condition.
7. The school is required to provide a Science lab for further expansion.
8. The school is required to submit an affidavit in original on non judicial stamp paper regarding non-proprietary character of the Society duly sworn in before a First Class Magistrate.
9. The school is required to use school name as per NOC in future.
17. The school is required to discontinue State Pattern classes, if any, as dual affiliation is not permissible as per Affiliation Bye-laws of the Board.

You are requested to submit a compliance report regarding removal of deficiencies and fulfillment of essential conditions prescribed under the Affiliation Bye Laws for affiliation of schools with supportive documentary evidence within three months from the date of issue of this letter.


